

Change to Middle School Detention Policy.

Effective Immediately:

Lunch Detention will no longer be held daily. Instead, Middle School students who are tardy to class, have a uniform violation, are eating candy or gum, or commit other minor violations of classroom procedures or school policies, will be issued detention slips as usual but will not serve an actual lunch detention.

- After three detentions issued, parents will be contacted by phone or email and the student will be given a 4-hour Saturday Detention, to be completed at the next scheduled Saturday.
- If the student is issued three Saturday detentions (9 detention slips issued), they will be given an In School Suspension (ISS) and a parent conference will be held to discuss the matter.
- After an ISS is issued, earning another three detentions (12 detention slips issued) will result in an Out of School Suspension (OSS) and the student, parents, and Middle School Director will meet to go over the Student Compact once more, resulting in a behavior contract.
 - Failure to meet the requirements of a behavior contract will result in student withdrawal or expulsion.
